Spring is on the way!



Construction updates

Building #20A: The installation of the siding is now completed. The electrical work is about 90% finished. We are awaiting an inspection of the building by the state electrical inspector and the code officer. The next steps to be done are insulating and sheet rocking. The finished product will be six air-conditioned rooms for couples. The couples will use the bathhouse in nearby building #13. Please pray that this project will be completed in time for Camp.



Pavilion

We would like to build a pavilion down by Trout Pond, where the old beach house is now located. The pavilion will include bathrooms for use by students at the beach, as well those in the tent area. By building the pavilion where the beach house is now, we can develop the tent area with more sites and night lights. The pavilion will be screened in, and there will be a fire pit inside for the hotdog cookouts on Sunday nights. This location will provide a nice view of Trout Pond as well. The cost to build will be approximately \$80,000.
